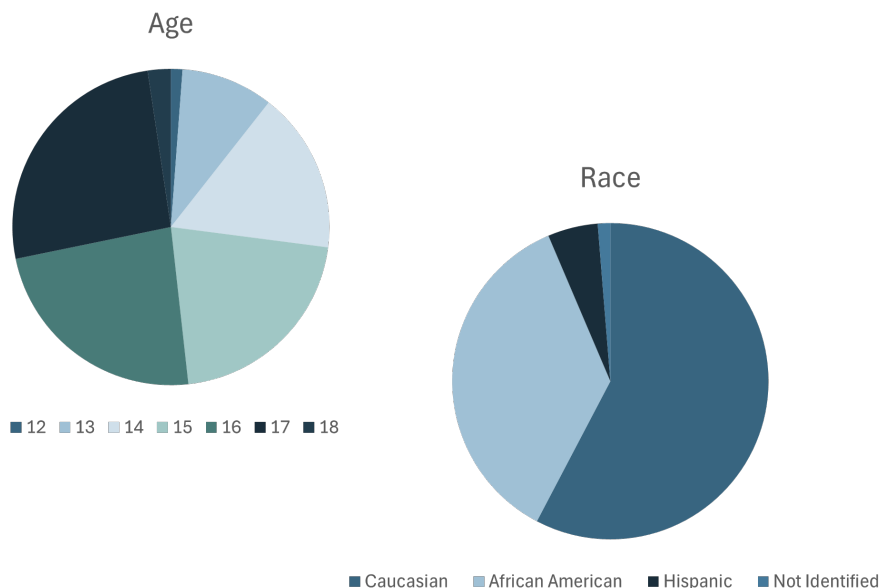
## 2024 ANNUAL REPORT



Harrisburg Juvenile Treatment Center is an Arkansas Department of Human Services program that serves adjudicated female youth ages 12 to 18 who present with a range of mental health and behavioral challenges.

Youth at Harrisburg receive comprehensive therapeutic and educational services, along with evidence-based group programming. Groups include Positive Skill Development (PSD), Positive Organizational Culture (POC), Seeking Safety, Aggression Replacement Training (ART), anger management, and character skill development sessions.

### 2024 OUTCOMES

- 15 years old was the average age in 2024
- 87% of discharges were successful exits
- 5 GEDs awarded
- 100% compliance with student IEPs
- 1.9 grade equivalent growth in reading
- 1.9 grade equivalent growth in math
